HIPAA 5010 Impact Assessment Service Offering

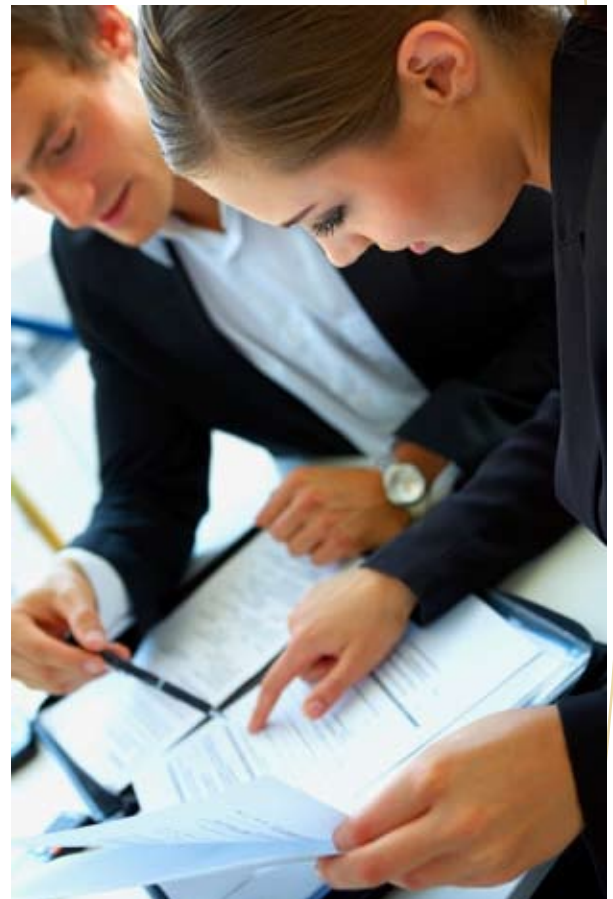
As a precursor to ICD-10 readiness, the industry must move to the next generation of the HIPAA electronic transaction standard. Health Plans must complete considerable research and planning to successfully operate under the new HIPAA 5010 standards. The scope and implications for this effort are significant.

With the major re-write of the HIPAA transaction standards, the industry projects more than 1,330 modifications spanning across all of the current 9 transaction standards. To achieve "Level 1 Compliance" by December 31, 2010, all organizations must be aligned to update and upgrade systems, tools and processes in support of the 5010 mandated changes. 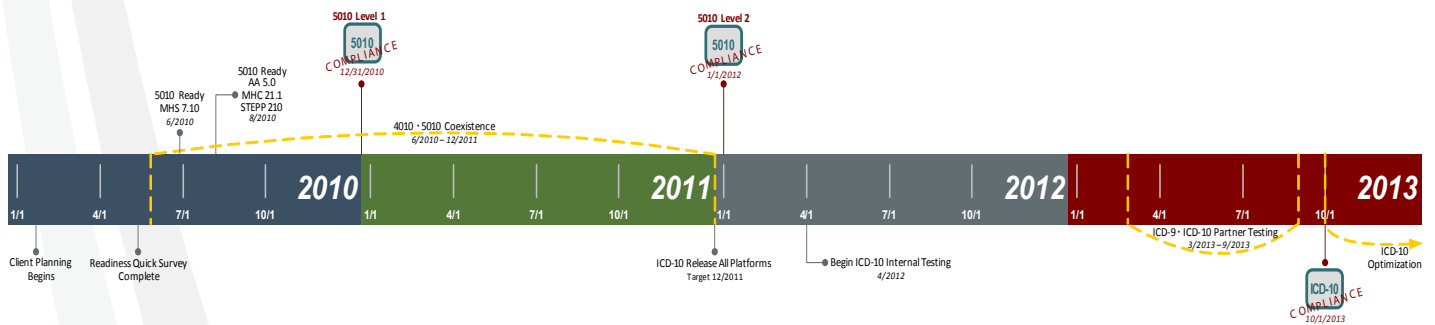

Activities	Duration
Create inventory of impacted health plan business processes, functions and activities; including 3 rd party applications and interfaces and custom surround code.	2 weeks
Overlay and map impacted health plan business processes, functions, and activities to the 5010 format. Overlay and map impacted health plan business processes, functions and activities to custom surround code and 3 rd party applications and interfaces.	1 week
Conduct compliance requirements analysis.	1 week
Review 5010 change opportunities to achieve business process improvements.	1 week
Refine and publish high-level process improvement recommendations.	1 week
